Legendary Irish singer-songwriter **Van Morrison** is set to christen brand new music venue **Nell's Jazz and Blues** with an exclusive live show on **November 3rd 2014**.

Nell's, a venue which will feature jazz singer/songwriters is managed by none other than **Vince Power**, founder of the Mean Fiddler in Harlesden.

The event is a rare opportunity to see **Van Morrison** in an intimate setting.

Van Morrison was born in Belfast in 1945 to a musical family, taking up multiple instruments while he was at school. He would go onto become a hugely influential artist cited by the likes of **Bruce Springsteen**, **Elvis Costello** and **Bono** as an inspiration. Rolling Stone describe him as an "enigma" and "an incredibly passionate vocalist whose concerts can generate serious heat".

This will be a very rare and intimate show for Van and for those of us old enough to remember, it will conjure up special memories of Vince's first venue, the legendary Mean Fiddler in Harlesden and the wealth of acts he promoted there including Van Morrison, Paul McCartney, Bob Dylan, Ray Charles, Roy Orbison, Jerry Lee Lewis and Johnny Cash to name just a few. Vince today commented:

'I am pleased to be back managing a live music venue and am excited that we have Van Morrison opening the venue for us. Having previously managed various venues across London I believe Nell's will provide something different and I am happy to bring exciting acts to this new venue.'
